## **STUDYING PROCCESS**

#### PROTECTION PROBLEMS AGAINST UNFAIR COMPETITION AND ADVERTISING

 The Law on Protection of Competition (LPC) prohibits unreasonable overestimation of one's own achievements and incorrect comparisons with other market participants. According to advertising law, advertisers cannot make unfounded claims about their product. Different norms lead to different violations.

#### ANTIMONOPOLY REQUIREMENTS FOR AUTHORITIES AND TENDERING

- An important part of the state regulation of trading activities is the establishment of restrictions for state authorities of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation and local governments.
- These restrictions have diverse focus.
- The main principles of tendering are their availability, openness and transparency in determining the results.
- Compliance with antitrust rules ensures adherence to these principles and makes tendering competitive.

### ANTITRUST COMPLIANCE

- Study of the systems of internal corporate processes and mechanisms aimed at preventing violations of antitrust legislation and the emergence of antitrust risks.
- Development, implementation and control of the necessary set of rules governing the behavior of the company and its employees in the market.





### S ANTITRUST REGULATION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

 Establishment of antitrust requirements for agreements and actions for the provision or disposal of rights to the results of intellectual activities. Prohibitions on anticompetitive agreements, as well as on the abuse of a dominant position in the market for goods produced using the results of intellectual activities.

#### **GOVERNMENT PRICE CONTROLS**

 Consideration of the principles of maintaining a balance between the economic interests of regulated entities and the consumer interests, price setting based on their economic feasibility, long-term price setting, ensuring equal conditions for consumers' access to regulated goods and others.

### LEGAL REGULATION OF INVESTMENT ACTIVITIES

 Means of interaction between the state and business in the creation and operation of special economic zones, the formation and use of the Investment Fund of the Russian Federation, increasing the efficiency of state development institutions, including development banks, state support for the activities of venture innovation funds financing high-tech and science-intensive projects.
