PROGRAM ADVANTAGES

- Double degree program: Master's degree of RUDN University with a staterecognized supplement on higher education and a European-standard supplement to the diploma (ECTS); Master's degree in Cultural Heritage: Research and Management from the University of the Balearic Islands (Spain) with a European Diploma Supplement (SET).
- Acquisition of practical skills, writing, and development of the projects to preserve and promote the cultural heritage of Russia and the Balearic Islands, and their implementation in practice.
- Access to international theoretical and applied knowledge, mastering Spanish researchers' experience in the study of cultural heritage.
- Classes are held in Spanish and Catalan, thanks to which students receive an excellent education, improving their professional level of the language.
- Better job opportunities in Russia and abroad. Graduates of this program work in international tourism organizations, cultural institutions (museums, archives, libraries, galleries), in state and local government (cultural manager), the media (PR-technologies), as well as in secondary specialized and higher education institutions.

STUDYING PROCCESS

120 credits.

(one year of study in Spain and one year of study in Russia). Lectures, workshops, and independent work, several types of practice.

The educational process for joint master's programs is implemented over four semesters of continuous education within the master's program of two partner universities as follows:

-• I and II semesters – at the University of the Balearic Islands in Spanish and Catalan;

- III and IV semesters – at RUDN University (teaching in Russian).

-• The defense of a master's thesis takes place at RUDN University in the presence of a professor from a partner university in Spain in Spanish.

Lectures, practical sessions, and students' individual work.

Program type: Research Master's program.

Degree offered: "Master of Arts and Humanities" (University of the Balearic Islands, Spain) and "Master of Arts and Humanities" (RUDN University, Russia).

Official transcript of the academic record in higher education, compatible with the pan-European diploma supplement in English.

Duration of study: 1st year of study – University of the Balearic Islands, Spain (Universidad de las Islas Baleares, Faculty of Philosophy, Department of Art Studies, specialization "Cultural Heritage: Research and Management") – 60 credits. 2nd year of study – at RUDN University (Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Department of "Arts and Humanities", specialization "Theory and History of Culture" – 60 credits).

The program languages are Russian, Spanish, Catalan.

First of all, participation in this master's program made it possible to understand Spanish and, in particular, Mallorcan culture, compare approaches to education in Spain and Russia, speak fluently in Spanish and start learning Catalan.
